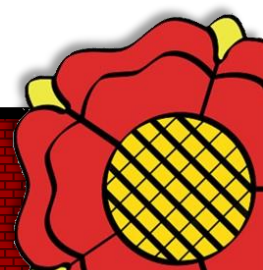
It was a **Y9 Rounders game** but we also had some great Y7s playing in preparation for their game. There is **a tournament** soon that the girls are gearing up for!
